This communication and presentation skills virtual seminar is a hands-on interactive three-hour three-session program designed to build and expand essential presentation skills from both content and delivery perspectives. The course has been developed for participants who want to improve their personal communication skills, their ability to deliver targeted, compelling and memorable presentations, and to handle difficult questions from stakeholders.

Participants should come ready to deliver a three-minute presentation as well as a short story about a project in which they have been involved. Feedback from peers and the facilitators will help participants improve their ability to connect from both content and delivery perspectives.

Course Program

Session 1 – The process, establishing a baseline, and stakeholders

- Introduction to developing powerful presentations
- Participants will deliver a three-minute presentation and receive immediate feedback
- Stakeholder definition, prioritization and analysis

Session 2 - Messaging and storyboarding

- Participants will develop a message to their original presentation
- Participants will deliver a "passion speech" introducing a story and emotion
- Structure and storyboard a presentation to address key stakeholders

Session 3 - Storytelling and Q&A

- Storytelling techniques
- Media techniques to confidently handle question and answer sessions
- Participants will put all pieces together and deliver a final presentation

	 By the end of the course, participants will be able to: Present in a more compelling way to internal and external stakeholders with increased confidence and capability Use skills and techniques to: Translate complex concepts into scalable and tailored messages for stakeholders Develop engaging narratives using storytelling models that showcase and differentiate their science/project Speak effectively face-to-face and online Confidently handle question and answer sessions Participants will receive all course materials electronically, a video taken from their presentation, as well as an individual one-page report highlighting their strengths and potential areas of development.
